

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council is advised that the presently available surplus book-keeping machines are not considered worth the cost of restoring them to workable order, and

WHEREAS, a proposal has been submitted by the National Cash Register Company whereby they will furnish new machinery necessary to adequately handle the ever-growing complexity of our office records for a cash price of \$8339.57 installed and set up for operation of two functions, and

WHEREAS, certain other expenses incidental to operating this machinery would thereby be incurred.

BE IT RESOLVED that this proposal be accepted and that Tribal Budget FY 1963-64 (TR 63-61) is hereby amended as follows:




