

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Willard and Bernice Malone, husband and wife, and Devore Thompson have applied for loans from the Revolving Credit Fund for home construction, and

WHEREAS, homesite lease is required by Section 23 (e) II of the Declaration of Policy and Plan of Operation approved January 19, 1961 and by Tribal Ordinance No. 44, and

WHEREAS, the Canyon Day Livestock Association on April 30, 1963 gave written permission to Mr. & Mrs. Malone to build a home on the Canyon Day Livestock Range, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has no objection to the use of the land by these individuals.

BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe do hereby approve and grant homesite leases to Willard and Bernice Malone and Devore Thompson for a period of 25 years at a rate of \$12.00 per year payable in advance on the first day of the month following the effective date of lease with an annual payment in a like amount on the same date each year thereafter in accordance with the terms of the lease for as long as the lease shall run.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman shall execute said lease for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in accordance with Tribal Ordinance No. 44; the effective date of the commencement of said lease being the date of the approval of the loan by the Secretary of the Interior or his designated representative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the loan not be approved in (120) one hundred twenty days from the date hereof, the lease shall thereby automatically terminate.

The foregoing resolution was on September 25, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
