RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the McKay No. 2 Logging Unit Contract, approved January 10, 1962 has cut 9,765,000 board feet to August 31, 1963 and has an allowable cut of 5,000,000 board feet during 1963, and
- WHEREAS, the purchaser, Charlson-Reidhead Logging Company has, on August 22, 1963, requested authority to cut up to 3,000,000 board feet in addition to the allowable maximum which is possible within the North Fork Block cutting budget.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the purchaser be authorized to cut the above additional volume subject to all of the provisions of the McKay No. 2 Logging Unit Contract.

The foregoing resolution was on September 25, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
