RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there is a dire need for water and sewage facilities in the North and South Whiteriver Townsites, and
- WHEREAS, U. S. Public Health Service has established similar facilities in other areas of the reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the U. S. Public Health Service is hereby requested to secure funds to make studies and establish a water and sewage system in the North and South Townsites of Whiteriver on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
