- WHEREAS, adequate harvest of surplus game animals is necessary in the practice of good game management, and
- WHEREAS, the sale of hunting permits is a source of income to the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized to set hunting permit fees for non-members.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the following hunting permit fees for non-members are hereby established for the year, 1964:

Bear	5.00
Javelina	2.00
Dove & Waterfowl	2.00
Predatory Animals	2.00
Guide Fee	25,00

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
