

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that certain members of the U. S. Congress are going to adopt to amend the President's Housing Bill, H.R. 9751 by deleting therefrom the public housing and urban renewal features of the bill, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apaches are in dire need of public housing units on the reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED that our Congressional Delegation be requested to support the H. R. 9751 in its present form.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman advise Congressmen, Udall and Senner of the Tribe's wishes by wire.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
