RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a need for additional refrigeration unit at the Whiteriver Service Station and liquor store, and

WHEREAS, revenue is being lost because of the lack of adequate refrigeration, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise has adequate cash on hand to purchase said refrigeration unit.

BE IT RESOLVED that Item 4, Page 72 improvements to Whiteriver Service Station of the White Mountain Recreation Budget is hereby amended to permit a capital expenditure of enterprise funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 to purchase of an additional refrigeration unit.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
