## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Recreation Enterprise has requested the Council to rescind its previous action of not granting permits to hunt bear and other predatory animals with hunting dogs, and
- WHEREAS, under a proper control system, the Tribe would benefit by the issuance of said licenses.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Recreation Manager is hereby authorized to issue permits for hunting bear and other predatory animals with hunting dogs.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Recreation Enterprise is hereby authorized and directed to establish fees for the said hunting permits.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
