

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. E. T. "Eddie" Williams, the present Corporation Commissioner of Arizona has been a friend of the Apaches for a number of years, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that he is well qualified to serve as a member of the United States Interstate Commerce Commission.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council unanimously endorses the said E. T. "Eddie" Williams for the position of membership of the United States Interstate Commerce Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Honorable Carl Hayden, United States Senator, and Congressman George F. Senner.

The foregoing resolution was on February 11, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
