BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby approved for payment, out of the Public Relations Fund, the sum of \$175.00 to be paid to the National Congress of American Indians as and for the White Mountain Apache Tribal dues.

for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,
pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended
Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958
and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
