RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Gayle A. Millet, former Manager, White Mountain Construction Enterprise, owes to the Tribe the sum of \$10,296.00 as and for materials, labor and overhead, said indebtedness being incurred by Gayle A. Millet pursuant to his using Tribal employees and construction enterprise materials in building a cabin on Lot No. B-226, Hawley Lake, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, repeated demands have been made upon Gayle A. Millet to pay said sums, and
- WHEREAS, for failure to pay said sums is a direct violation of Paragraphs 15 and 16 of the lease of the premises by and between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the said Gayle A. Millet, and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council that the said lease be terminated, and
- WHEREAS, George S. Kilpatrick likewise owes the Tribe the sum of \$7,041.98 for labor and materials and overhead furnished the said George S. Kilpatrick in constructing his cabin on Lot No. A-81, Hawley Lake, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, repeated demands have been made upon George S. Kilpatrick to pay said indebtedness.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman and Tribal Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to immediately notify Mr. Gayle A. Millet that his said Hawley Lake Lot Lease is terminated, effective 30 days from the receipt of notification by the Chairman.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Attorney are authorized and directed to notify George S. Kilpatrick that his Hawley Lake Lot Lease likewise be terminated for violation of Paragraphs 15 and 16 of the said lease if payment is not received within 30 days of receipt of said notice.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
