

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it has been the policy not to issue cinder permits in excess of 500 cubic yards without the approval of the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, numerous permits are issued for 500 cubic yards or less when a larger volume could be sold.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized to issue permits for cinders, gravel and sand in lots of not to exceed 2,000 cubic yards without the approval of the Tribal Council at the current appraised value provided by the U. S. Geological Survey.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that permits in excess of 2,000 cubic yards and those permits issued free of charge shall not be issued without the approval of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
