## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the U. S. Post Office Department Regulations require that all rural Post Offices be operated by contract in the name of an individual, and
- WHEREAS, James D. Sparks, the Recreation Manager, in order to operate the Hawley Lake Rural Station, he would have to sign a contract with the U. S. Postal Department regarding said operation.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe affirms the authority of Mr. James D. Sparks to sign a contract with U. S. Post Office Department in his own name covering the rural station at Hawley Lake.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all funds received by Mr. James D. Sparks be paid to the Recreation Enterprise by Mr. Sparks.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
