

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe is expanding its business activities, and
WHEREAS, there are many construction projects on the reservation, and
WHEREAS, in some instances the contractors have done inferior work, and
WHEREAS, the Council desires to insure, as far as practicable, that persons
will receive value for money spent in construction.

BE IT RESOLVED that all contractors, subcontractors and persons doing
construction work at an hourly rate be required to furnish to the
Tribal Council, copies of all of their pending contracts and that
hereafter all of said persons be required to furnish copies of
their contracts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that until such contractor, subcontractor or other
persons agree to comply with this requirement that they not be
issued a license to do business on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The Foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10
for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,
pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended
Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
