WHEREAS, the State Highway Department, State of Arizona has been requested to take in to the Arizona State system, the Hawley Lake Road, and


WHEREAS, the State of Arizona desires a right of way agreement with the Tribe.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent and the Chairman are authorized to sign a right of way agreement with the Highway Department, State of Arizona covering the Hawley Lake Road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said right of way agreement provide, among other things, that said road shall not be used by loaded logging trucks.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
