BE IT RESOLVED that the Branch of Forestry cruise and appraise the Williams Canyon Logging Unit as this appears to offer a good area for logging during inclement weather.

The foregoing resolution was on March 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
