

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Reidhead & Chlarson Lumber Company, Inc., purchase of the Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit, Contract Number 14-20-0450-5026, has cut and paid for 5,054,270 board feet of timber from this unit during calendar year 1965, and

WHEREAS, the minimum annual cut for the Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit in 1965 was 14,000,000 board feet leaving a deficit of 8,945,730 board feet, for which relief has been requested, and


WHEREAS, this deficit constituted an approximate loss in revenue of \$110,000.00 to the tribe in 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Reidhead & Chlarson Lumber Company contracted to complete the Cibecue sawmill on or before April 1, 1965.

BE IT RESOLVED that this request for relief be denied and that this deficiency be made up in 1966 at the penalty stumpage rates specified in Section 6 (2) of the Standard Timber Contract Provisions.

The foregoing resolution was on March 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
