

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, partial relief from the minimum cutting requirements on the Deer Springs Canyon Logging Unit, Contract Number 14-20-0450-5334, No. 65-168 passed December 1, 1965, and

WHEREAS, there are some technical difficulties in administering this modification, and

WHEREAS, the reasons for granting partial relief as covered in Resolution No. 65-168 appear valid.

BE IT RESOLVED that relief from the minimum cutting requirements for calendar year 1966 be granted, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Section 13 of this contract be modified as follows:


13. Cutting Schedule

- (a) Minimum Annual Cut. The Purchaser shall cut and pay for not less than 10,500,000 board feet during calendar year 1966 and not less than 7,500,000 board feet each subsequent calendar year.
- (b) Maximum Annual Cut. The maximum volume of timber that may be cut during calendar year 1966 shall be 12,500,000 board feet and not more than 9,000,000 board feet each subsequent calendar year.

The foregoing resolution was on March 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
