RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Canyon Day Livestock Association unanimously requested the Tribal Council to designate that part of Range Unit 12 lying southwesterly from the present sales corrals to the Fort Apache Junction, commonly known as the Buying and Selling Pasture, be reassigned to Range Unit 1, Canyon Day Livestock Association, and

WHEREAS, the Buying and Selling Project has no further need for said land.

BE IT RESOLVED that the said area is hereby assigned to the Canyon Day Livestock Association.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Canyon Day Livestock Association is hereby authorized to construct such additional traps and corrals and facilities deemed necessary to improve staging of cattle sales in this area.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
