## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney's Contract expires on August 9, 1966, and
- WHEREAS, Barry DeRose, Tribal Attorney, has performed good and faithful service for the White Mountain Apache Tribe and in many cases in excess of his present contract, and
- WHEREAS, the present enterprises and the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe have progressed with the advice and guidance of Barry DeRose, and
- WHEREAS, the growth of old enterprises and the establishment of new enterprises have increased the working load of the Tribal Attorney.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to renew his contract, for a period of three years from August 10, 1966, at a salary of \$1,000.00 per month.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
