

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to establish per diem rates for the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, members of the Tribal Council, the Tribal Secretary, all Committee members, including, but without limitation, enterprise committees and Board Members, and


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council that all Council members shall hereafter be paid a salary of \$22.00 per day or any fraction thereof.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, members of the Tribal Council, the Tribal Secretary, all Committee members, enterprise committees and Board members shall be reimbursed at the rate of \$25.00 per diem or any fraction thereof and ten cents per mile for use of personal vehicle for business transacted off the reservation and at the rate of \$4.00 per diem plus ten cents per mile for personal vehicle when assigned to duty away from station, but within the boundaries of the reservation.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all Council members be hereafter paid the sum of \$22.00 per day or any fraction thereof for attendance at Council meetings, Committee meetings and such other meetings and/or trips as designated by the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on July 19, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
