RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the law now provides that one third of the Community Action Program Advisory Board be elected by the people whom they serve.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Community Action Advisory Board be increased from five members to nine members.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that one of the members be elected from Seven-Mile, one from North Fork, one from Canyon Day, one from Cibecue and one from McNary.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
