

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Rev. Arthur Alchesay Guenther has for many years served as the Lutheran Minister, and

WHEREAS, in this capacity he has indoctrinated many Apache people in the Lutheran religion, and

WHEREAS, this has greatly helped these people attain a high recognition and moral standard, and

WHEREAS, in addition to his ministrual accomplishments he has been active in assisting the Apache people in many of their personal problems, and

WHEREAS, he has given, unselfishly, his time to the betterment of the community, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council would be proud to have him as a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that Rev. Arthur Alchesay Guenther is hereby appointed an honorary member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that he be granted a free Tribal Hunting and Fishing License and that he be allowed to kill one deer each year, one turkey each year and one elk every three years.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
