RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, a new enterprise has been established on the reservation commonly known as the White Mountain Apache Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the Council desires to establish a Board of Directors to administer and manager the said enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council that a five-man board be established, two of the members of the said board to be non-White Mountain Apaches.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the following persons are hereby appointed for the terms stated as members of the White Mountain Apache Enterprise Board of Directors:

1.	Raymond Kane	One year
2.	West Anderson	Two years
3.	Mrs. Luna Kessay	Three years
4.	Joe Dora	Four years
5.	Neal Hall	Five years

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members so appointed shall elect a Chairman from their membership.

The foregoing resolution was on March 20, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
