


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a great need for additional farming equipment on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the immediate purchase of three tractors and other farming equipment is necessary.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit with the Treasurer of the United States the sum of not to exceed \$9600.00 to purchase the necessary tractors and farm equipment.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
