


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company has constructed a new dirt road from East Fork Highway to the Fort Apache Timber Company, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this road be maintained.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby required to designate and include the said road into its Bureau of Indian Affairs Road System.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
