RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Managing Editor of the Fort Apache Scout now receives a salary of \$200.00 per month, and
- WHEREAS, the income from subscription, advertising, etc., for the year 1966 was the sum of \$2500.00, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe desires the Managing Editor's salary to be raised to a sum not to exceed \$400.00 per month, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe desires that the income from advertising and other sources be increased to defray the cost of increasing the said salary from \$200.00 to \$400.00 per month.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Managing Editor's salary is hereby raised from \$200.00 not to exceed \$400.00 per month effective June 1, 1967 provided; however, that the income from the advertising or subscription equals or exceeds the sum of \$408.00 during the month of May, 1967 and each succeeding month thereafter and if said sum does not exceed the sum of \$408.00 per month, the Managing Editor shall receive all of the income from the Scout received from the advertising or subscription in excess of \$208.00 per month to a maximum of \$400.00 salary per month.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
