RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the anticipated income for the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1967 and ending April 30, 1968 will be \$900,034.00, and
- WHEREAS, in order to provide funds for the continuation of certain Tribal activities for education and welfare purposes for members of the Tribe and for the development, protection and conservation of reservation resources and for other purposes during the 1967-68 fiscal year, such activities to cost \$843,036.00.
- BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby authorized and appropriated from tribal funds on deposit with the Treasurer of the United States the sum of \$843,036.00. Said funds are to be expended in accordance with the items listed in the budget attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Treasurer shall make disbursements of tribal funds appropriated herein only upon vouchers authorized by properly designated tribal employees and approved by the Chairman and Chief Accountant.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all remaining unobligated balance as of April 30, 1968 are hereby cancelled and such unobligated balances shall be returned to the General Account of the Tribe, PROVIDED, that additional or supplemental funds may be provided by appropriate amendments to this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
