## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Imus Concrete Company desires to maintain a portable cement batch plant on the land formerly leased to the Arizona Highway Department across the highway from the Hon-dah Service Station, and
- WHEREAS, the said Imus Concrete Company has a contract to furnish cement for the new to be constructed bridges on Highway 73, Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized to issue a revocable permit to the Imus Concrete Company to put and maintain a cement batch plant on approximately near the junction of Highway 173 and 73, Navajo County, Arizona.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Imus Concrete Company pay to the White Mountain Apache Tribe the sum of \$100.00 for said permit.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said batch plant be removed within three months from the date hereof.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
