

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Roads is prohibited by Title 25 Code of Federal Regulations from maintaining roads on the reservation which are not a part of the Bureau Road System, and

WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Pow-wow road is in use each summer during the annual community Pow-wow and during other rodeos, and


WHEREAS, plans are being prepared for using this road for a site for an Apache Indian Drama which will be held at least weekly, and


WHEREAS, the success of these enterprises depend upon an adequate access road.

BE IT RESOLVED that the following reservation road be added to the Bureau Road System on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
