## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has an active game management and conservation program, and
- WHEREAS, there is a surplus number of certain game species on the Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the sale of hunting permits provides an important source of income to the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Game Department and the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors has made recommendations to the Council for the setting of seasons and bag limits.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the attached NON-MEMBER game regulations, seasons and bag limits be adopted for the 1967-68 season.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
