RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has a continuing program of lake construction and development of recreational facilities, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe encourages its members to fully utilize the fishing and facilities provided, and
- WHEREAS, an increasing number of Tribal members are participating in sport fishing and enjoying the benefits derived therefrom.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the daily bag and possession limit for members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and others permitted to fish under the provisions of Ordinance No. 14 be set at fifteen (15) fish.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 4 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
