## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe through its White Mountain Apache Enterprises has constructed a restaurant at Hon-Dah on the junction of State Highway 73 and 173, and
- WHEREAS, the manager of the White Mountain Apache Enterprises has recommended that the restaurant be leased on a percentage of gross, and
- WHEREAS, Webb C. Gregg and Maxine W. Gregg have applied for a lease of the Hon-Dah Restaurant.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Hon-Dah Restaurant be leased to W. C. and Maxine W. Gregg for a period of four years with an option for renewal for an additional four years at a rental rate of \$3,000.00 per year or five percent of gross sales of all items except jewelery which would be at the rate of ten percent of gross whichever amount is greater is to be paid by the lessee.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby directed and authorized to execute said lease as presented to the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on June 21, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
