RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to cooperate with the State Highway
 Department in roads maintenance and construction on the Fort Apache
 Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the State Highway Department has requested permission to secure cinders from the Hawley Lake Junction pit and Cooley Mountain Truck Trail pit for highway maintenance on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED that permission is hereby granted to the Arizona State Highway Department to secure cinders for maintenance from the Hawley Lake Junction Pit and Cooley Mountain Truck Trail Pit.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State Highway Department is hereby requested to construct a cattle guard on Highway 173 at the entrance from the highway to the Hawley Lake Junction Pit said cattle guard to be constructed as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on June 21, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
