RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Charles A. Patterson has operated the Apache Construction Company for a period of one year in an exemplificatory manner under a land and equipment lease granted by the White Mountain Apache Tribe dated June 7, 1966 by and between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Charles A. Patterson, and
- WHEREAS, the last paragraph of the said lease provides for a term of one year from June 7, 1966 to June 7, 1967 with an option to renew for a set term of two years commencing on the 7th day of June, 1967 and ending June 7, 1969, and
- WHEREAS, Charles A. Patterson has advised the Tribal Council that he wishes to exercise his option to renew the lease for a two year period.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the said lease on land and equipment is hereby extended for a period of two years under the same terms and conditions as or incorporated in the original lease.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
