

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a considerable volume of timber in small sawlogs which cannot economically be manufactured in existing sawmills on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, this lack of utilization constitutes a loss of revenue to the Tribe from stumpage payments and job opportunities, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a detailed study to determine the best possible means of integrating the small sawlog production into existing facilities, and


WHEREAS, under the terms of Public Law 89-136, the United States of America has authorized the making of supplementary grants and/or loans to public bodies and private or public non-profit organizations or associations to aid in financing the construction of specific public projects.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be and he is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe with the Economic Development Administration, U. S. Department of Commerce, for a supplementary grant to aid in financing a small log manufacturing study on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent, Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the Economic Development Administration, U. S. Department of Commerce, may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe will pay 1/4 of the cost of such study to a maximum of \$5,000.00 as their contribution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
