RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Edward Barr desires to construct a canteen in the Cibecue area, and
- WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that such a canteen is needed in the community of Cibecue.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign for and on behalf of the Tribal Council a 25 year traders lease paying the same percentage payments as other traders pay for doing the same type of business on the reservation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby requested to appraise the area being leased and that Mr. Edward Barr pay as and for an annual lease rental fee of the appraisal as determined by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing resolution was on July 18, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
