WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Central Tribal Accounting Office currently is using the services of the Service Bureau Corporation located in Phoenix, Arizona to process tribal payrolls and accounts payable, and


WHEREAS, it would be to the best advantage of the Tribal Enterprises and Managers to utilize their services with rights to all accounting records, and

WHEREAS, the Service Bureau Corporation has advised that the use of their facilities would cost approximately \$350.00 a month plus an initial program charge of \$2500.00, and


WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Tribal Council that the use of these facilities would be a benefit to the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$2850.00 is hereby appropriated from funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasury.

The foregoing resolution was on July 18, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
