

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the funds budgeted for school clothing and emergency food grants are exhausted, and

WHEREAS, the tribe expends only a small percentage of its total gross income for welfare.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasury an additional sum of \$3,000.00 for the purchase of school clothes by the Welfare Department and an additional \$3,000.00 for emergency food grants, said sum to be administered by the Agency Welfare Department.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
