RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Herd Enterprise is noted for its high quality breeding stock, and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council to maintain and improve the registered breeding herd of the Tribal Herd Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, there has been budgeted only \$5,000.00 for replacement cattle for the current fiscal year, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Herd Manager, with approval of the Tribal Herd Board of Directors, has made a tentative purchase of registered breeding stock from Sellman Bros. Hereford Ranches of Watrous, New Mexico, pending budgetary approval.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council approves the addition of a sum of \$5,000.00 to add to the replacement cattle account to make the sum a total of \$10,000.00.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this approval is granted because of the good cattle sales of this fall and the fact that the Tribal Herd Enterprise will show a net profit for the fiscal year.

The foregoing resolution was on November 14, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
