FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Hon-Dah Restaurant does not have an adequate sign, and

WHEREAS, a proper sign would tremendously increase the business of  
the Restaurant, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Enterprise does not have the funds  
to purchase a sign.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds  
the sum of \$3500.00 to be granted to the White Mountain Apache  
Enterprise for the purchase of a sign to be located at the  
Hon-Dah Restaurant.

The foregoing resolution was on December 6, 1967 duly adopted by a vote  
of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain  
Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section  
1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by  
the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior  
on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
(48 Stat. 984).
