RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Western Asbestos Manufacturing Company, Inc. has failed to comply with several provisions of their lease, Contract No. 14-20-450-5454, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council recognizes its responsibilities toward the economic development of the natural resources of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Area Director is requested to give notice to Western Asbestos Manufacturing Company, Inc. that they have thirty (30) days to pay their annual rental, begin mining operations and to diligently pursue the development, and file monthly and annual statements as required by their lease or the lease will be cancelled.

The foregoing resolution was on December 6, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1, (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
