RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the preparation of a Population Support Capacity document is an integral part of the P.P.B.S., and
- WHEREAS, a Population Support Capacity document must be prepared for this reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Business College of the University of California has offered assistance in the preparation of a Population Support Capacity document for this reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs plans to conduct surveys of the various reservation populations and desires to conduct an advance survey on the Fort Apache Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, better statistical data will be useful in Bureau of Indian Affairs and tribal programs, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs proposes to use tribal members to conduct the surveys and agrees to pay interviewers at the rate of \$1.00 per completed interview.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that permission to prepare the Population Support
 Capacity is hereby granted to the University of California.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council gives its cooperation in conducting this population survey.

The foregoing resolution was on December 6, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
