

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Cooley Ranch House had been in existence since the late 1800's,  
and

WHEREAS, the said Cooley Ranch House was recently destroyed by fire, and

WHEREAS, this Cooley Ranch House had not only great historic value but also  
certain sentimental value to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that it is the unanimous intention of the Tribal Council to  
see that the said Cooley Ranch House is restored as nearly as  
possible to its original condition.

The foregoing resolution was on June 26, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10  
for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,  
pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended  
Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958  
and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
