


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the upper log road has been engineered and if constructed will cost a total of \$12,000.00 which if approved will be financed through the Road Suspense Account, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Forestry Committee has reviewed the proposed road expenditure and recommends approval of this addition to the Forest Road System.

BE IT RESOLVED that the upper log road be approved as proposed and that its construction be funded under the Road Suspense Account.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
