RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribe under its former construction enterprise had purchased a rockcrusher, and
- WHEREAS, this rockcrusher, for some time, has not been in use and is rapidly depreciating in value, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has no further use for the said rockcrusher, and
- WHEREAS, Charles Patterson has offered to purchase the rockcrusher for the sum of \$5,000.00 cash.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute a Bill of Sale for and on behalf of the Tribal Council to Charles Patterson, the transfer in title of said rockcrusher from the Tribe to Charles Patterson and the payment to the Tribe of the sum of \$5,000.00 cash.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
