

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the General Livestock Association has requested the Tribe to permit the Business Office to handle bookkeeping records of the Association, and


WHEREAS, the said Association has offered to pay to the Tribe, as and for the cost of maintaining said bookkeeping records, the sum of \$3,000.00 per annum, and


WHEREAS, the Business Office Administrator has advised the Council that the sum of \$3,000.00 is adequate for bookkeeping and payroll records.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Office is hereby authorized and directed to incorporate all bookkeeping and payroll records of the General Livestock Association into the Tribal Central Accounting System.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the General Livestock Association, as and for the cost of maintaining said records, to pay the Tribe the sum of \$3,000.00 per annum.

The foregoing resolution was on March 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
