RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to preserve and protect its valuable wildlife resources and provide maximum hunting opportunities for members of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise conducts continuing game surveys and applies modern game management techniques as a part of its assigned responsibilities, and
- WHEREAS, the Enterprise Board of Directors have made recommendations regarding game season, regulations and bag limits.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the attached 1969-1970 game seasons, regulations and bag limits for members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be approved by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
