WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is a harvestable surplus of certain game species on the Reservation, and


WHEREAS, the sale of hunting permits is an important source of income to the Recreation Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors has made recommendations regarding game seasons, regulations and bag limits for non-member hunting.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached non-member 1969-1970 game seasons, regulations and bag limits be approved by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
