## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the number of White Mountain Apache students in higher education has more than doubled within the past year, while at the same time, the number of High School graduates have greatly increased, and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to provide summer employment of these youngsters, Post High School and College Students, and
- WHEREAS, Office of Economic Opportunity, Neighborhood Youth Corps, Buraau of Indian Affairs and other funds previously used have been drastically reduced.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that not to exceed \$20,000.00 be set aside from Section XV General Miscellaneous Account No. 36-7710, Contingency Fund, to pay salaries and taxes for those college students and Post High School students who can find no other employment.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
